ANNUAL GOLF CLASSIC “HITS THE MARK” IN RECORD TOTAL FOR LOCAL HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

GRATZ, Pa. (May 23, 2008) – On June 1st, MI Windows and Doors will reach a record setting \$1 million in donations to Habitat for Humanity of the Greater Harrisburg Area through their annual Golf Outing at the Hershey Country Club.

Nearly 250 golfers will play in the event raising the record-setting funds. The donations will be used by Habitat for Humanity to help build homes for families in need throughout the Greater Harrisburg Area.

“There are many families in our backyards that do not have adequate housing. With the help of our customers, vendors and friends, we are able to help change that,” said Matt DeSoto, MI’s president of the eastern division.

Since 1998, MI has organized the annual golf outing to help Habitat for Humanity carry out its mission of building decent, affordable homes for deserving low income families. “MI’s contributions have assisted us in fulfilling our quest of eliminating poverty housing in the Greater Harrisburg Area,” states Eve Wachhaus, executive director.

Over the past ten years, MI and its partners have raised \$1 million in the Golf Outing, with both participation and total money raised increasing each year to help those in need of decent shelter.
